

Eldora City Council
Special Meeting
February 18, 2020 – 5:00pm

Eldora City Council met with Mayor David Dunn presiding. Council members Aaron Budweg, Greg Priske, Cindy Johns and Melody Hoy were present. Also, present were Chandra Kyte, Zak Stoulil and Jerry Kramer.

The council has one item on the agenda, a motion to give the Mayor authority to sign the 28E Agreement with Greenbelt Home Care. Zak Stoulil was on hand for council questions. The new 28E will have the County in at 99% and the City at 1%. The county has already accepted the new 28E agreement. There is another company from MN, Recover Health that was moving into this area. They have asked the current employees of Greenbelt Home Care to move over to them and as of today Zak does not know of any employees that have accepted their offer. The Board of Health would like a 5-member board and the current 28E agreement only has 3-member board. Council member Hoy motioned to approve giving the Mayor authority to sign the 28E agreement, seconded by Budweg. Roll call vote: “ayes”: Hoy, Budweg, Jones, Priske and Jones; “nays”: none; absent: none. Motion carried.

Mayor Dunn asked for a motion to adjourn. Council member Johns so moved; meeting adjourned at 5:31 pm.
