

Eldora City Council
Special Meeting
March 5, 2020 – 5:30pm

Eldora City Council met with Mayor Pro Tem Blake Jones presiding. Council members Aaron Budweg, Greg Priske, Cindy Johns and Melody Hoy were present. Also, present were Chandra Kyte and Brent Hinders and Matt Rezab.

The meeting started with the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Pro Tem Jones asked for a motion to go into Closed Session under **Iowa Code 21.5(1)(c) Threat of Litigation**. Council member Hoy so moved, seconded by Priske. Roll call vote: “ayes” Hoy, Johns, Jones, Priske and Budweg; “nays”: none; absent: none. Motion carried. Closed Session opened at 5:35 pm.

Mayor Pro Tem Jones asked for a motion to open the Closed Session. Council member Johns so moved, seconded by Priske. Roll call vote: “ayes” Johns, Budweg, Hoy and Jones; “nays” none; absent: none. Motion carried. The Closed Session closed at 6:03 pm and went into Open Session.

The council then discussed wage adjustment for Chandra Kyte and Ryan Sutcliffe. Chandra has finished clerk school and received her certification on June 12, 2019 and the council recommended for the March 10th meeting a resolution for a \$1.00 per hour increase. Ryan’s director fee was also discussed, and the council would like to get some comparison from other Cities and their wage base. The also discuss the wage base for new hire for the EMS and some future adjustment to it. This will be reviewed at a later meeting.

Chandra reviewed some items for the March 10th meeting. She will email a sewer loan refinance opportunity. Dee Priske was confirmed to manage the pool this season. A selling policy, purchase policy and the current credit card policy along with another city’s policy will be emailed to the council. Some discussion on the semi ordinance and clarification was made. Adding no parking in R-1, R-2 or R-3 will be added to the ordinance and adding parking in designated City area. The changes will be sent to Erika for review.

Mayor Pro Tem Jones asked for a motion to adjourn. Council member Jones so moved; meeting adjourned at 6:50 pm.
