

Eldora City Council
Special Council Workshop
October 20, 2021 -- 6:00 pm

Eldora City Council met in Special Council Session with Mayor David Dunn presiding. Council members Jerry Kramer, Blake Jones and Greg Priske were present along with and City Administrator Aaron Budweg and Chandra Kyte. Also, present were Duane Hahn, Mike May Jr, Trevor Fisher, Chad Brekke, Lary Koosmann, Luke Wilson, Matt Garber Mark Kuiper, Jerry Shoff and Chip Schultz.

The Mayor opened the workshop and everyone rode on the tram and toured the 11th Avenue project. Tim Harless was our driver. Clappsaddle-Garber gave an overview of the project. The culvert by the pasture will be made larger for better flow. Some of the manholes will be replaced. They will be adding a 10 foot bike trail along 11th Avenue. Alliant is evaluating removing the poles and installing underground service, but Mediacom uses some of Alliant poles. Some trees and shrub will have to be removed for the bike trail along with some hydrants that will be needed to move further back from the road. The group looked at all the patch work on the street from each repair made over the years. They plan on installing sidewalks on both side of the street. The water pipe will go from a 4 inch to an 8 inch. This will better serve the school and fairground. They reviewed the storm intake by Blake Jones house where it floods when there is too much rain. Further in the future, the City would like to add to the bike trail and make a path by the school and FS building to Twister Park. The Lutheran Church would like to see 11th Avenue wider by the church for preschool drop offs. They also discussed a drop off lane or making parking on one side only (the north side) M-F.

Mayor Dunn asked for a motion to adjourn. Council member Jones so moved; meeting adjourned at 6:33 pm.
