

**ORDINANCE NO. 884**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 OF THE ELDORA MUNICIPAL CODE**

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Eldora, Iowa:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend section 90.18 of Chapter 90, of the Eldora Municipal Code by deleting section 90.18 and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

**“90.18 SHUTTING OFF WATER SUPPLY.** The Director of Utilities may shut off the supply of water or assess a monthly surcharge of \$100.00 to any customer because of any violation of the regulations contained in these Water Service System chapters that is not being contested in good faith. The supply shall not be turned on again until all violations have been corrected that the Director of Utilities has ordered the water to be turned on.”

Section 2. Effect. All other Sections of said Chapters shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of the Code is, for any reason, held to be invalid or enforceable as to any person or circumstances, the application of such section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it shall be held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby, and all other provisions of the Code, in all other respects, shall be and remain valid and enforceable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance and the Eldora City Code shall be in full force and shall take effect, from and after the adoption and publication of this ordinance.
