RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING STREET CLOSING FOR THE HARDIN COUNTY FAIR
PARADE

WHEREAS, the Hardin County Fair Board has requested that the following streets be closed for the purpose of conducting the Hardin County Fair Parade on Wednesday, July 7, 2021:

15th Street south to Edgington Avenue; east on Edgington Avenue to Washington Street to 14th Avenue; east on 14th Avenue to 12th Street; north on 12th Street to 11th Avenue; then east on 11th Avenue to the Fairground.
Highway 175 closed from 15th Street east to 10th Street

WHEREAS, such street closings would not adversely affect residents or businesses in the area.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Eldora hereby approves closing the above listed streets for the purpose of conducting the Hardin County Fair Parade on July 7, 2021 from 5:45 p.m. to 7:15 p.m.
