

Whereupon Council Member Johns moved that the following Resolution be adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 09-20-2903

RESOLUTION REQUESTING REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE IOWA
COVID-19 GOVERNMENT RELIEF FUND; WITHIN THE CITY OF
ELDORA, HARDIN COUNTY, IOWA.

WHEREAS, this Resolution by the City of Eldora is to request reimbursement for eligible costs related to the COVID-19 public health emergency from Iowa COVID-19 Government Relief Fund; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress approved the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act to provide economic relief related to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Governor Kim Reynolds allocated \$125 million of the State of Iowa's CARES Act funding to local governments for direct expenses incurred in response to the COVID-19 emergency; and

WHEREAS, local government funding reimbursements may only be used for necessary expenditures incurred due to the COVID-19 pandemic, were not accounted for in the current fiscal year city budget, were incurred during the time period of March 1, 2020 through December 30, 2020 and have not been reimbursed from other sources.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City of Eldora affirms that the above requests for reimbursement follow all formal published Federal and State of Iowa guidance on how the funds should be spent, and understand if the reimbursements are misrepresented, the local government will be liable for any applicable penalty and interest.
