RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING STREET CLOSING FOR TRUNK & TREAT

12<sup>th</sup> Street from Edgington Avenue to 12th Avenue and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 12<sup>th</sup> Street to the alley north of the Eldora Library, where the street will be closed to all through traffic
