RESOLUTION TO RE-APPOINT CITY ATTORNEY

**WHEREAS**, the current city attorney for the City of Eldora term has expired on September 2020; AND

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eldora would like to renew the contract with Erika Allen as the City Attorney for the City of Eldora with compensation as set forth in the 2019 bid;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Eldora, Iowa hereby reappoints Erika L Allen as the City Attorney of the City of Eldora.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the compensation for Erika L Allen as City Attorney of the City of Eldora shall be an annual retainer of \$1,000.00, which includes five hours of legal work during the calendar year, (October 1, 2020 – December 30, 2021) with any additional work compensated at the rate of \$175 per hour. Attendance at meetings, drafting of documents, office or teleconferences, will be billed at her hourly rate, commuting to meetings will be billed at one-half of her hourly rate.
