RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION FOR TAX EXEMPTION UNDER THE URBAN REVITALIZATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELDORA, IOWA

WHEREAS, Harold Meyer has filed a tax exemption application with the City of Eldora, Iowa, requesting a tax exemption on their property located within the City of Eldora Urban Revitalization District, with a copy of said tax exemption attached hereto and made a part of hereof by this reference; AND

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eldora has examined the said applications and has found that the improvements constructed or proposed to be constructed as set forth in the applications qualifies the improvements on qualified real estate and that the value of the properties improved may be improved by the requisite amount; AND
