INFORMATION SHEET

Welcome to the City of Eldora! We are pleased to have you join our community. Here is some information to help you get acquainted with the City.

We have 2 public parks that have shelter, picnic and playground areas. Twister Park has a swimming pool, tennis courts and little league ball fields. Memorial Park has the beginning of a bike trail that goes to Pine Lake State Park and then on to Steamboat Rock.

The Eldora Public Library is located across the street from the Eldora-New Providence Elementary School. Their hours are 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. with some later hours during the week.

The City of Eldora operates under the mayor-council form of government. The Council consists of five Council members at-large with staggered terms. The mayor is elected for a term of two years.

City Council meets on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers on the lower level of City Hall using the south entrance. All meetings are open to the public and you are cordially invited to attend.

The Eldora Police Station is located on the lower level of City Hall using the south entrance.

UTILITIES: The City of Eldora provides water, sewer and solid waste utility service. We bill monthly for these services. Your bill is mailed on the 1st of each month and is due by the 15th of that month. A penalty of 10% with a minimum of \$5 per service is added on the 16th. For your convenience, there is a drop box in the door of City Hall and also in the alley behind City Hall.

UTILITY DEPOSIT: A Utility Deposit of \$150.00 is required of all renters. Utility Deposits will be applied to your final bill.

PERMITS: A permit is required for driveways, curb cuts, sidewalks (new and repairs), signs, dumpsters, trees and any building additions or changes that you might make. Permits can be picked up at City Hall. They need to be returned to City Hall and approved before the work can be done.

RECYCLING: Eldora has an active recycling program. The north side of Edgington is picked up every other Tuesday and the south side of Edgington every other Thursday. Call Hardin County Solid Waste Disposal at (641-939-5808)
